

There being no additional nominations, Mr. Yancisin entertained a motion to adopt the slate of officers and directors as presented. He asked all those in favor of adopting the slate of officers and directors to signify by saying “Aye.” Mr. Yancisin declared the slate duly elected and commissioned on behalf of The Arc Baltimore effective July 1, 2025.

In the President’s remarks, Ms. Wynn reflected on the past year, during which The Arc Baltimore reaffirmed its mission to support individuals with developmental disabilities in leading fulfilling lives. We welcomed new Board Members and increased direct support professionals' wages to \$20 per hour. Throughout the year, we have provided multiple training & professional development to enhance staff support and supervision. Notably, all 700 staff members completed a two-day seminar on person-centered thinking. Additionally, our Community Employment Team successfully helped over 50 individuals find jobs, and our Project SEARCH program welcomed 22 high school interns. Lastly, Ms. Wynn highlighted that we received certification for Standards for Excellence from Maryland Nonprofits, an Honor Roll Award from Executive Alliance, and that Kathleen Durkin was recognized as one of Maryland’s Most Admired CEOs for 2024 by The Daily Record, acknowledging her excellence and leadership.

The business meeting was concluded, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:14 pm.
